

# INR 300-cr govt fund in offing to deal with scrap tyres: R Mukhopadhyay, JK Tyre

The Raghupati Singhania Centre of Excellence (RPSCOE), JK Tyres' global technology centre, is ramping up its R&D infrastructure by procuring additional equipment to enhance the testing and product development capabilities.
